Itinerary

Day 1, Thur. Sept. 22: USA-SHANNON. Depart JFK International Airport on your Aer Lingus flight #110 which departs at 6:20 p.m. Dinner followed by in-flight entertainment shortly after take-off.

Day 2, Fri. Sept. 23: SHANNON - ARDRAHAN - SPANISH POINT: Early morning arrival into Shannon Airport. After clearing Irish Customs, you'll be met by your Irish driver/guide and escorted to your awaiting motor coach. Leaving Shannon Airport we travel the short journey to Ardrahan for a visit to **Rathbaun Farm**. Here you'll enjoy seeing a sheep shearing demo, see the dog herd the sheep and enjoy fresh-made farmhouse scones with tea/coffee and your host Frances. Continue into County Clare arriving in Spanish Point around lunch time. Check into the hotel with remainder of the day to rest, relax or explore. **Dinner** and overnight at the **Armada Hotel**, Spanish Point.

Day 3, Sat. Sept. 24: SPANISH POINT - CLIFFS OF MOHER - CLIFDEN: After breakfast, we depart Spanish Point to the nearby **Cliffs of Moher**, rising to a height of 700 feet above the Atlantic and extending along the coast for nearly five miles. From here you can gaze far out into the Atlantic, picking out the form of the Aran Islands in the distance. From the cliffs we travel via the towns of Lisdoonvarna, Ballyvaughan, Oranmore, through the Burren region to Galway City. Continuing through the Connemara Region and finally arriving in Clifden in the afternoon. **Dinner** and overnight at the **Alcock & Brown Hotel AND the Foyles Hotel**, Clifden.

Day 4, Sun. Sept. 25: CLIFDEN: After breakfast, you are at leisure in Clifden to enjoy the **Clifden Arts Festival**, featuring music, poetry, theatre, dance and the visual arts which come together to enthrall and entertain. Or if you choose, today is a great day to take up a round of golf on your own. **Dinner** and overnight at your Clifden hotel.

Day 5, Mon. Sept. 26: CLIFDEN - BALLYGALLY. After breakfast, depart Clifden and travel north-east to Ballygally in Northern Ireland. This journey take us via Westport, Castlebar through County Sligo. Stop in Drumcliffe to visit the Drumcliffe Churchyard, set against the striking backdrop of the Benbulbin Mountains. It is best known as the final resting place of W.B. Yeats. Continue today to County Fermanagh, officially crossing into Northern Ireland now. We skirt Lough Neagh and head north now passing through Killead, Templepatrick and Bally Easton, arriving in Ballygally in the late afternoon. Check into your castle hotel for **dinner** and overnight at the **Ballygally Castle Hotel**.

Day 6, Tues. Sept. 27: BALLYGALLY-LARNE-CAIRNRNRYAN-OBAN: Early morning departure after breakfast from your hotel to the **Larne Ferry Port**. You'll bid a fond farewell to your Irish driver, guide and board your ferry for foot passage to Cairnryan, Scotland. Upon arrival you'll meet your Scottish guide and board your coach. Travel via Loch Lomond and the Trossachs National Park to Oban. Enjoy a visit to the **Oban Distillery**, established in 1794. Experience the malt whisky making process and learn the secrets which make Oban Malt whisky taste so unique. Check into your hotel for **dinner** and overnight at the **Columba Hotel** in Oban.

Day 7, Wed. Sept 28: OBAN-LOCH NESS-INVERNESS: After breakfast, depart Oban and travel through the Highlands and Fort William to Loch Ness. Here enjoy a **short cruise with entrance to Urquhart Castle**. Urquhart Castle, on the banks of Loch Ness, remains an impressive stronghold despite its ruinous state. Once one of Scotland's largest castles, Urquhart's remains include a tower house that commands splendid views of the famous loch and Great Glen. Your journey continues on to Inverness. Check into your hotel for **dinner** and overnight at the **Inverness Hotel**.

Day 8, Thur. Sept. 29: INVERNESS-EDINBURGH: Enjoy a **panoramic city sightseeing tour of Inverness** and then you travel southerly to Blair Atholl with a visit to **Blair Castle**. Discover Blair Castle and go on a journey into the fascinating past of the Dukes and Earls of Atholl. Unique amongst Scottish castles, the story told here will take you from a visit by Mary Queen of Scots to the Civil War, and from the Jacobite cause to the disaster of Culloden following Bonnie Prince Charlie's own stay in the castle. You'll hear how the lucky inheritance of a smuggler-infested island helped turn the castle into a comfortable home, and learn how Queen Victoria's famous stay led to the creation of Europe's only private army, the Atholl Highlanders. Continue south now via Dunkeld and Perth to Edinburgh. Check into your hotel for **dinner** and overnight at the **Mercure Hotel**.

Day 9, Fri. Sept. 30: EDINBURGH: This morning you'll discover Edinburgh with visits to **Edinburgh Castle**, a historic fortress which dominates the skyline of the city of Edinburgh; the **Palace of Holyroodhouse**, the official residence of her majesty the Queen of Scotland and the Queen's Gallery which houses changing exhibitions from the Royal Collection. Afternoon is free to shop and independently explore this vibrant city. Tonight enjoy a **farewell 3-course dinner with one drink and live music at Gillie Dhu Restaurant**. Overnight at your Edinburgh hotel.

Day 10, Sat. Oct. 01: EDINBURGH - DUBLIN - JFK: Early morning departure from your hotel you'll be transferred to Edinburgh Airport for your short flight to Dublin, Ireland. Here you'll connect with your flight back to JFK. Arrive home the same day.
